
Skiing:

On February 10th, 1973, over 700 skiers from Virginia, The District of Columbia and Maryland turned out to test our slopes for the first time. Today, Massanutten is one of the Mid- Atlantic's premier snow resorts with over 2 million skiers and snowboarders having experienced the joy of sliding on our snow. No longer just a "ski" area, Massanutten welcomes snow- boarding and snow tubing. Known for firsts, Massanutten boasts being the first in Virginia to offer snowboarding, offer snowtubing, have the first quad chairlift, light all 14 trails for night skiing. Massanutten has 1100 feet of vertical-the most in Virginia, Maryland and Pennsylvania. If you ski, snowboard, snowtube or want to learn how, Massanutten is the place to be.

Snowboard:

Since opening the CMB Terrain Park, Massanutten has established its reputation as having one of the premier parks in the Mid-Atlantic region. In addition to the CMB Terrain Park, the Easy Street Terrain Park can be accessed by riding the Geronimo Lift #3. Easy Street uses smaller features catering to the learning process of novices. Easy Street is now located on the skiers right on Geronimo. The Park's staff grooms, hand shapes and changes the layout of both parks daily to keep them fresh. Each day, Terrain Park reports are posted in the rental shop and on the website, providing the layout of the parks and useful tips to make your day in the parks more enjoyable. The CMB Terrain is open to snowboards, snowblades, and skis. Massanutten rental are not allowed. Our parks will continue to be the best by offering more trails and other challenging features for your park riding experience.



Tubing:

Nearly everyone can enjoy sliding on snow at the Peaked Mountain Express Tube Park. Enjoy the thrill of our 900 foot long hill and let our SunKid Wonder Carpet take you back to the top. Our two hour sessions now begin every hour on the hour, beginning at 9AM with the last session beginning at 8 PM. Cost is \$25.

Ice Skating:

We are adding a new twist for those who don't want to go skiing this year. If you are interested in Ice Skating, Massanutten is offering an opportunity for fun. 90 minute sessions for \$20.

Waterpark:

The indoor portion of Massanutten Water Park is open year-round and is always 84 degrees Fahrenheit. It has awesome opportunities like Flow Rider, Meltdown Slides, Inner Tube Slide, etc. For more information please check out the website at massresort.com Cost is \$30.
